Little Free Library FAQ

Where can I find Little Free Libraries?

Currently, Little Free Libraries are located at Powell Butte Store and the lobby of the Fire Station at Juniper Canyon.

Who can use Little Free Libraries?

Anyone can use Little Free Libraries! No library card, proof of residency, photo ID, or secret handshake is required. There are books for everyone!

How long can I keep Little Free Library materials?

Little Free Library materials can be kept for as long as readers need to finish the item. Little Free Libraries are all about sharing – please return items when you are finished so the next Little Free Library visitor can find a book.

How can I donate materials to my local Little Free Library?

Individual books, magazines, audiobooks, and other materials can be placed in the Little Free Library. If you have more than a couple items, please bring them to Crook County Library to be distributed to the Little Free Libraries.

I want to do more! How can I help maintain the Little Free Libraries?

There are privately maintained Little Free Libraries found throughout the county that are not affiliated with Crook County Library.

May I return regular Crook County Library materials to a Little Free Library?

No. Regular library materials (i.e. materials with a Crook County Library barcode on the front cover) must be returned to Crook County Library to be checked in and circulated in the library collection.
