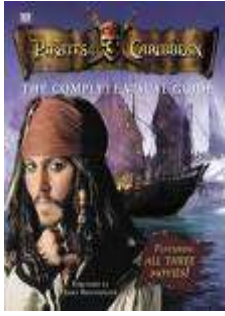
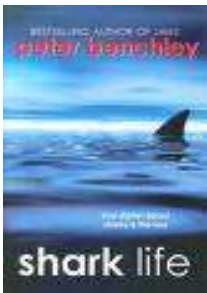
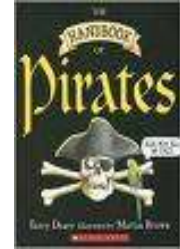

The Handbook of Pirates by Terry Deary– Everything you need to know about pirates - all the gore and more! Prepare yourself for the truth behind the legends and lies!



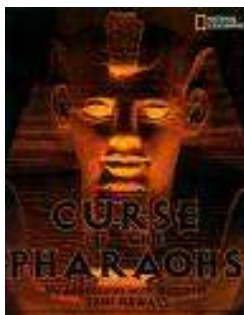
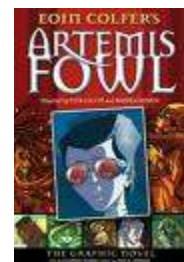
